1. **SCUPPER (Verb)**

Meaning: Thwart or destroy



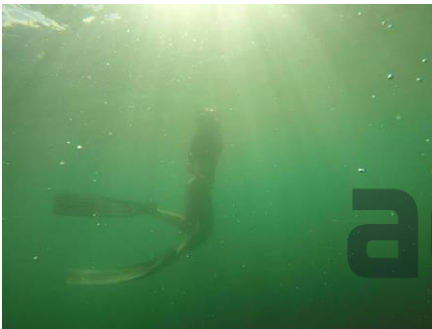
Antonyms; promote, construct

Synonyms; destroy, devastate

2. **MURKY (Adjective)**

Meaning: Hard to see through, as a fog or mist

Dark, dim, gloomy



Antonyms: clear, bright

Synonyms: cloudy, dark

3. **HYSTERIA (Noun)**

Meaning; Behavior exhibiting excessive or uncontrollable emotion



Synonyms: attack, wildness

Antonyms: calmness, contain

4. **REFRACTORY (Adjective)**

Meaning: Obstinate and unruly; strongly opposed to something.



Flintobox

Synonyms: insubordinate, intractable

Antonyms: compliant, obedient

5. **DEROGATORY (Adjective)**

Meaning: Tending to derogate, or lessen in value of someone;



"You want to get married? —
that is so gay!"

Synonyms: pejorative

Antonyms: complimentary

6. **HUE (Noun)**

Meaning: A color, or shade of color; tint; dye.



Synonyms; kind, Sort

7. **PERSIST (Verb)**

Meaning: To continue to exist.

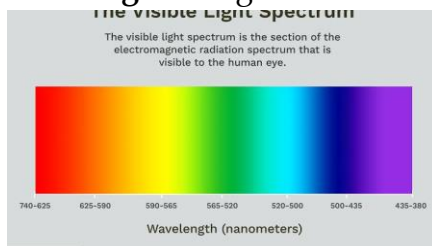


Antonyms: hinder, stop

8. **SPECTRUM (Noun)**

Meaning: A range



Synonyms; range, scope

9. **REVEAL (verb)**

Meaning: To uncover; to show



Synonyms; tell, disclose

Antonyms; hide, camouflage

10. **GRANULAR (Adjective)**

Meaning: Consisting of, or resembling, granules or grains



Synonyms: powder, uneven

Antonyms: even, regular
