**Synonyms:** inattentive, distracted

3. **PIQUANT (Adjective)**

**Meaning:** A brief battle or clash

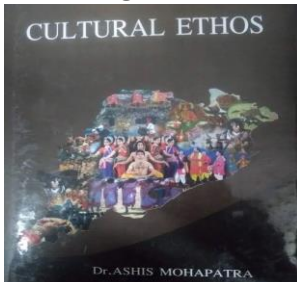


**Synonyms:** confrontation, fight
