

## VOCABULARY

1. **DISCORD (Noun)**

**Meaning:** Lack of concord, agreement or harmony.

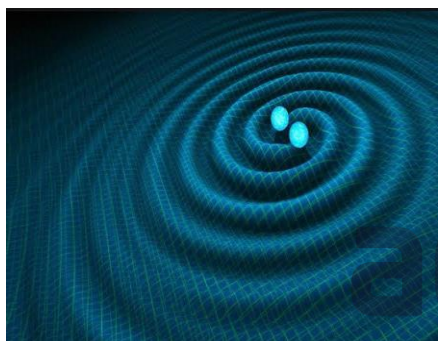


**Antonyms:** accord, agreement

**Synonyms:** conflict, hostility

2. **SWAY (Verb)**

**Meaning:** To move or swing from side to side; or backward and forward;



**Antonyms:** steady

**Synonyms:** swing, oscillate

3. **HAZY (Adjective)**

**Meaning:** Not clear or transparent.



**Synonyms:** unclear, foggy

**Antonyms:** clear, sunny

4. **BRACE (Verb)**

**Meaning:** To prepare for something bad, such as an impact or blow.

**Synonyms:** strengthen, fortify

**Antonyms:** drain

5. **CONSPIRACY (Noun)**

**Meaning:** plot, An agreement between two or more persons to break the law at some time in the future.

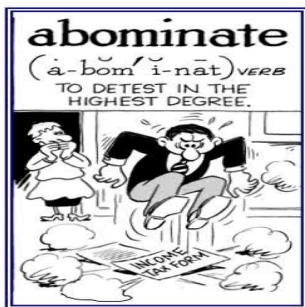


**Synonyms:** deception, collusion

**Antonyms:** congress

6. **ABOMINATE (Verb)**

**Meaning:** To dislike strongly



**Synonyms:** despise

**Antonyms:** admire

7. **INCITEMENT (Noun)**

**Meaning:** A call to act; encouragement to act, often in an illegal fashion.



**Antonyms:** suppression, discouragement

**Synonyms:** provocation, persuasion



8. **PERVERSE (Adjective)**

**Meaning:** Obstinate in the wrong; stubborn; intractable; hence, wayward; vexing; contrary.



**Synonyms:** irrational

**Antonyms:** innocent, docile

9. **MOBILISATION (Noun)**

**Meaning:** the act of bringing forces/people/resources together for a particular cause.



**Synonyms:** gather

**Antonyms:** demobilization,

10. **SCRUTINY (Noun)**

**Meaning:** Thorough inspection of a situation or a case.



**Synonyms:** inspection, investigation

**Antonyms:** glance
