1. Evangelize (verb)

Meaning; To preach any ideology to those who have not yet been converted to it.



Synonyms: preach, lecture Antonyms: endure, dissuade

2. Commence (verb)

Meaning; To begin, start



Synonyms: begin, start Antonyms: wait, halt

Scrupulous(adjective) 3.

Meaning; Exactly and carefully conducted.



Synonyms: aware, careful Antonyms: careless, unaware

4. Vilify (verb)

Meaning; To say defamatory things



Synonyms: defame **Antonyms:** commend

Sabotage (verb) **5.**

Meaning; To deliberately destroy or damage something in order to prevent it from being successful.



Synonyms: Destroy, damage Antonyms: construct, make

Galling (Adjective) 6. Meaning; humiliating



Synonyms: annoying, bothersome Antonyms: comforting, consoling

7. Embellish (verb)

Meaning; To make more beautiful and attractive; to decorate.



Antonyms; destroy, deconstruct Synonyms; adorn, decorate
