1. Covenant (noun)

Meaning; An agreement to do or not do a particular thing.



Synonyms: agreement, accord **Antonyms**: disagreement, denial

Bedeck (verb) 2.

Meaning; To deck, ornament, or adorn; to grace.



Synonyms: embellish, decorate

Antonyms: deface, denude

3. Repudiate (verb)

Meaning; To refuse to have anything to do with; to disown.



Synonyms: abondon, deny Antonyms: accept, approve

4. Broach (verb)

Meaning; To open, to make an opening into; to pierce.



Synonyms: raise, introduce **Antonyms:** reserve, conceal

5. Empyrean (adjective)

Meaning; of the sky or the heavens



Synonyms: Paradise Antonyms: hell

6. Dastardly (adjective)

Meaning; in the manner of a dastard; marked by cowardice



Synonyms: evil, heinous Antonyms: noble, nice

7. Panoply (noun)

Meaning; A splendid display of something.



Synonyms: array **Antonyms:** dullness
