

SYNONYMS AND ANTONYMS

FARE (Verb) सफल रहना

Meaning: perform in a specified way in a particular situation or over a particular period.

Synonyms: Precede progress, manage, and cope.

Antonyms: cease, regress, suppress, retard.

Usage: We'll also give you exclusive analysis of how each team fared over the weekend.

ADJUDICATION (Noun) न्यायिक निर्णय 2.

Meaning: a formal judgment on a disputed matter.

Synonyms: arbitration, decision, assessment, verdict.

Antonyms: incomprehension, indecision, enigma, amnesty.

Usage: Articles 5 and 6 both deal with the promptness with which adjudication must proceed

against criminal defendants.

DOWNRIGHT (Adjective) सर्वथा 3.

Meaning: (of something bad or unpleasant) utter; complete (used for emphasis).

Synonyms: total, absolute, thorough, perfect, sheer.

Antonyms: inadequate, incomplete, insufficient, and unfinished.

Usage: It was downright bad marking that allowed Dermot Shields head past Larkin from six

yards for the lead goal.

ACQUITTAL (Noun) रिहाई 4.

Meaning: a judgment or verdict that a person is not guilty of the crime with which they have been charged.

Synonyms: absolution, exoneration, exculpation, liberation.

Antonyms: conviction, accusation, incrimination, indictment.

Usage: Now the choice is go to trial on a felony assault charge and hope for an acquittal or plead guilty to a misdemeanor.

REMIT (Verb) छोड़ना 5.

Meaning: cancel or refrain from exacting or inflicting (a debt or punishment).

Synonyms: revoke, repeal, rescind, abrogate.

Antonyms: heed, mark, note, object.

Usage: The judge refused to remit the young man's cavalier disregard for his pile of unpaid speeding tickets.

ACUMEN (Noun) कुशाग्रता 6.

Meaning: the ability to make good judgments and take quick decisions.

Synonyms: shrewdness, acuity, cleverness, smartness.

Antonyms: guilelessness, ingenuousness, artlessness, fatuity.

Usage: But generally I prefer policies that demonstrate a scintilla of common sense and financial acumen.

7. CONDIGN (Adjective) अनुरूप

Meaning: (of punishment or retribution) appropriate to the crime or wrongdoing; fitting and deserved.

Synonyms: earned, merited, warranted, and justifiable.

Antonyms: unjust, undue, unsuitable, and unfair.

Usage: I may pity him, and even understand his motives, but a murderer is still deserving of condign punishment.

8. PERSUASION (Noun) अनुनय

Meaning: a belief or set of beliefs, especially religious or political ones.

Synonyms: opinion, conviction, faith, view.

Antonyms: dissuasion, distrust, constraint, disbelief.

Usage: Political leaders and women of all political persuasions are expected to attend the commemorations.

EXEMPTION (Noun) मुक्ति 9.

Meaning: the action of freeing or state of being free from an obligation or liability imposed on others.

Synonyms: indemnity, exclusion, freedom, relief.

Antonyms: liability, accountability, obligation, responsibility.

Usage: If they get exemption from rent control law, their income would increase several times.

10. PLAUDIT (Noun) प्रशंसा

Meaning: an expression of praise or approval.

Synonyms: acclamation, commendation, encomiums, accolades.

Antonyms: condemnation, criticism, vilification, admonition.

Usage: The film smoothly rides on its success, earning the plaudit of being one of the highestever grosser in the Malayalam film industry.

11. LANGUISH: दुर्बल

Meaning: to exist in an unpleasant or unwanted situation, often for a long time

Synonyms: dwindle, faint **Antonyms:** build, develop

Usage: After languishing in obscurity for many years, her early novels have recently been rediscovered.

12. PUMMEL: कूटना

Meaning: to defeat someone easily at a sport

Synonyms: bash, batter

Antonyms: compliment, fail

Usage: The boxer had pummeled his opponent into submission by the end of the fourth round.

13. ARCTIC: उत्तरी ध्रवी

Meaning: extremely cold **Synonyms**: cold, freezing **Antonyms:** hot, torrid

Example: Arctic air stung New England with freezing temperatures.

14. SCALDING: गरम

Meaning: If a liquid is scalding, it is extremely hot

Synonyms: blazing, blistering

Antonyms: cold, cool

Usage: Against her will, hot scalding tears burst from her eyes and down her cheeks.

15. ABOMINATE: घृणा करना

Meaning: to hate something very much

Synonyms: abhor, despise Antonyms: admire, approve

Usage: Eventually one has to bring people together and sit down with those whose records one

abominates.

16. DOWNGRADE (Verb) अधोगति

Meaning: reduce to a lower grade, rank, or level of importance.

Synonyms: decline, declivity, descent, dip, hill, inclination

Antonyms: ascent, improvement, increase, rise **Usage:** His career has been on the downgrade.

STRINGENT (Adjective) कड़ी से कड़ी **17.**

Meaning: not allowing for any exceptions or loosening of standards

brassbound, **Synonyms:** cast-iron, exacting, hard-line, inflexible, rigid, rigorous,

Antonyms: flexible, lax, loose, relaxed, slack

Usage: There are stringent rules against unauthorized persons

being in our building



18. EGALITARIAN (Noun): समानाधिकारवादी

Meaning: one who advocates or practices social equality.

Synonyms: democrat, leveler

Antonyms: snob, snoot

Usage: As egalitarians, some people have always promoted policies for equal pay.

19. SOJOURN (Noun) विराम

Meaning: a temporary stay at one place, esp. while traveling.

Synonyms: stay, tarry, visit, stopover.

Antonyms: journey, migration, departure, advance.

Usage: During Dean's sojourn in Paris, he spent two weeks visiting all of the city's cultural

attractions.

20. INCUR (Verb) झेलना

Meaning: become subject to (something unwelcome or unpleasant) as a result of one's own behavior or actions.

Synonyms: provoke, earn, arouse, induce.

Antonyms: avoid, shun, elude, evade.

Usage: The surgery wasn't what scared the sick man; it was all of the medical bills he would

incur from the procedure.

XENOPHOBIC (Adjective) अज्ञातजन भीति/ विदेशी द्वेश 21.

Meaning: having or showing a dislike of or prejudice against people from other countries.

Synonyms: racist, racialist, ethnocentric, ethnocentrist.

Antonyms: bountiful, permissive, thoughtful, lenient.

Usage: As a result, the new parliament is distinctly more xenophobic and illiberal than its

predecessor.

22. APARTHEID (Noun) रंगभेद

Meaning: a policy or system of segregation or discrimination on grounds of race.

Synonyms: prejudice, bias, bigotry, favoritism.

Antonyms: anti-discrimination, anti-racism, anti-segregation, assimilationism.

Usage: Incredibly, a decade after the end of apartheid this system still exists.

VEST (Verb) निहित होना 23.

Meaning: confer or bestow (power, authority, property, etc.) on someone.

Synonyms: entrust, invest, bestow, confer.

Antonyms: impede, inhibit, disqualify, disbar.

Usage: Extensive powers were vested into the hands of the President who headed the executive

branch of government.

24. BLATANT (Adjective) সৰল

Meaning: (of bad behavior) done openly and unashamedly.

Synonyms: flagrant, glaring, undisguised, overt.

Antonyms: imperceptible, inconspicuous, unnoticeable, unobtrusive.

Usage: To credit the newspaper, they did retract the quote once it was exposed as a blatant lie.

25. MURKY (Adjective) ध्रंधला

Meaning: dark and dirty or difficult to see through

Synonyms: cloudy, dark **Antonyms:** bright, luminous

Example: The river was brown and murky after the storm.

Manifestations (Noun) अभिव्यक्तियों 26.

Meaning: the action or fact of showing something.

Synonym: display, demonstration Antonym: ambiguous, clouded,

27. Disorientation (Noun) भटकाव

Meaning: the condition of having lost one's sense of direction.

Synonym: addle, baffle **Antonym:** reassure, satisfy

28. Convulsion (Noun) ऐਂਠਜ

Meaning: a violent social or political upheaval.

Synonym: upheaval, eruption

Antonym: calm, peaceful

29. Delirium (Noun) प्रलाप

Meaning: wild excitement or ecstasy.

Synonym: ecstasy, rapture **Antonym:** lucidity, coherence

30. Dysfunction (Noun) रोग

Meaning: disruption of normal social relations.

Synonym: Impaired

Antonym: Unimpaired, fit

31. LOUSY(Adjective)घटिया

Meaning: very bad

Synonyms: awful, horrible **Antonyms:** good, great

32. GUSSY(Verb) सुशोभित

Meaning: to make someone or something look more attractive or impressive

Synonyms: adorn, beautify **Antonyms:** deface, spoil

COGNIZANCE(Noun) हस्तक्षेप, संज्ञान 33.

Meaning: To take notice of and consider something, especially when judging

Synonyms: Awareness, Familiarity **Antonyms:** Unfamiliar, Ignorance

34. AGGRIEVE(Adjective)पीड़ा देना

Meaning: To make someone unhappy and angry

Synonyms: Offend, Hurt **Antonyms:** Please, Praise

Meaning: to secure tightly

Synonyms: bind, band Antonyms: unbind, untie



VOLITANT(Adjective)तेजी से उड़ना 36.

Meaning: flying or moving about rapidly

Synonyms: floating, soaring **Antonyms:** slow, grounded

PLUNK(Verb)लापरवाही से नीचे रखना

Meaning: to put something down heavily and carelessly

Synonyms: drop, dump **Antonyms:** glob, incline

38. PANDER (Verb) बढ़ावा देना

Meaning: gratify or include (an immoral or distasteful desire or taste or a person with such a desire or taste)

Synonyms: indulge, gratify, satisfy, yield. **Antonyms:** dissatisfy, deny, refuse, disturb.

39. BRACE (Verb) सहारा देना

Meaning: prepare (someone) for something difficult or unpleasant.

Synonyms: nerve, gird, strengthen, fortify. Antonyms: dampen, deaden, drain, debilitate.

SMUG (Adjective): आत्मसंतुष्ट

Meaning: having or showing an excessive pride in oneself or one's achievements.

Synonyms: bighead, complacency, egotism, vainglory.

Antonyms: diffidence, bashfulness, demureness, shyness.
